To place a carnation(s) on the altar for Father’s Day in honor or memory of fathers, please complete a form in the back of the church and place it in the collection basket by June 11th.

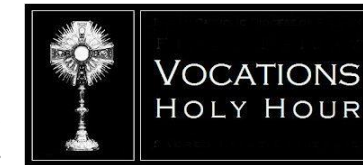
LVRSA Fundraiser @ Kevin’s Cafe

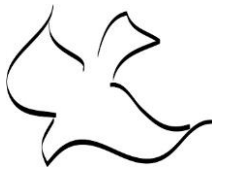
