The photo of the church altar above is believed to be half of the original altar in St. Francis Xavier Church erected in the 1700's. Prior to the erection of Holy Angels Church in Avenue, MD in 1904, several homes in the 7th District were regularly used as mass stations. When a new altar was installed in St. Francis Xavier Church in the early 1800's, the old altar was removed and divided in two parts for use in two of these homes.

One half went to the home of Mrs. James Bailey and was destroyed by fire. The other half went to the home of Mr. Aloysius Mattingly (Collingwood) at Abell, MD. Here it was use and remained until Collingwood was torn down in the 1968, at which time it was presented to the St. Mary's County Historical Society by Mrs. Elizabeth Mattingly Russell.
