From the Pastor

Dear parishioners,

Please note that starting Wednesday, July 12th, SFX's daily Mass will return to its former time of 8 a.m. The earlier daily Mass time enables people that have to go to work to attend daily Mass.

Highspeed reliable WiFi is coming! SFX's office currently uses a cellular internet connection that is very slow, unreliable, expensive and downright frustrating. Over the past year the archdiocese's accounting and parish management systems have migrated to an on-line and archdiocesan-wide "cloud" environment. So, highspeed reliable WiFi has become a critical need. However, with our parish being so far out on the peninsula, options are very limited. After consultation with the archdiocese, the only viable option is cable WiFi. However, due to our location and being alone out on the end of Newtowne Neck Road, we have to pay the initial construction of laying the cable. I am pleased to announce the archdiocese will pay the \$16,463 cost for the construction and installation of the cable lines to the parish. Not only will this enable our office systems to work well, we can also have WiFi in the parish hall that can be used by religious education and for many events we hold in the hall that can benefit from connectivity. I am very grateful to Cardinal Wuerl for this generous gift to SFX.
